 Welcome home! You certainly know how to plan an exciting itinerary. I'm anxious to hear your first hand accounts of the current situations in Korea and the Philippines. In the meantime, what follows is an update on a variety of issues. I've highlighted a few questions or request for immediate action.

USA VOTES

The following has been scheduled:

September 14th: Edgar Bronfman, his office in New York, 5:00 p.m. Abe Feinberg will be joining us at this meeting. Marife Hernandez and I are working on other New York appointments starting at 4:00 p.m. and ending with a 7:00 a.m. breakfast on September 15th.

September 15th: Phil Klutznick, Whip Office, 11:00 a.m. I was originally trying to schedule Klutznick for the Chicago trip on October 23rd (details below). He will be in Israel on the 23rd but will be in Washington on September 15th for a speaking engagement. Myrna tells me that he recently pledged \$1.0 million to Hebrew University.

September 16th: At a reception at Elizabeth and Smith Bagley's home the National Democratic Institute for International Affairs will announce that you have been selected as the recipient of this year's W. Averell Harriman Democracy Award (letter from Mondale is attached). As the letter states this award is as much for what you are doing currently for voting in this country as it is for your lifetime of work promoting democracy and human rights abroad. Obviously, they would like you to attend the reception which is scheduled for 6-8 p.m.

September 24th: Charles Keating, Whip Office, 3:00 p.m. I was originally trying to schedule a trip to Arizona on September 18th, but Keating was not going to be in Arizona on that date so instead he is coming to Washington on the 24th. I've attached an article from the Wall Street Journal which talks about the views of the new FHLB Chairman, Danny Wall; views that obviously are good news to Keating. You should ask Keating for \$250,000.

October 2nd: Harry Freeman, Whip Office, 2:00 p.m. As you may recall, while Harry works in New York for American Express he still lives in Washington, so a meeting in D.C. was as easy for him as New York. You should ask Harry for \$100,000 from American Express for Forum Institute. I don't think they will do more than \$50,000, but I'd still ask for the higher figure. C-800061
