

1           Q       Did there come a time when you had a  
2 conversation with Ms. Sedlmayr, Senator DeConcini's staff  
3 person, regarding Senator Riegle's involvement?

4           A       Yes, sir. At least once.

5           Q       Would you please tell the Committee just what  
6 that discussion was?

7           A       We had been sharing notes about the meetings  
8 since the March 19th meeting. And at one point, I remember  
9 that we were discussing Senator Riegle's involvement, which  
10 was somewhat mysterious to both of us.

11          Q       Why was it mysterious?

12          A       Because we had the letter from Riegle. I think  
13 Laurie had a little more information -- I don't know that  
14 for sure -- she may have had more information than I did.

15                   But it seemed to be both our impressions that  
16 Senator Riegle was involved in trying to set up a meeting  
17 with Ed Gray.

18                   Laurie told me that she had called someone in  
19 Riegle's office and that that person had subsequently  
20 discussed something with Riegle who went back to Senator  
21 DeConcini who told Laurie not to talk to Senator Riegle's  
22 staff at Senator Riegle's request.
